

## Win a Suzuki Terms and Conditions

The "Win a Suzuki" prize competition is a promotion for the 2019/20 Suzuki Triathlon National Championships and any other events included or excluded deemed by Triathlon NZ\*. To enter into the prize competition, you must compete in one or more of these events and pay the relevant entry fee. If you are under the age of 18, you must have the consent of a parent or guardian to be eligible.

Entry is only open to New Zealand residents. Members of the Tri NZ Board, employees and their immediate families, paid High Performance contracted coaches, High Performance funded athletes and Tri NZ's associated Sponsors and employees are ineligible to be in the draw to win.

### **Event Day Entry**

Each entry into an Event in the 2019/20 Suzuki Triathlon National Championships will make you eligible for one entry into the draw. You must enter specifically for the draw on the day of competition by completing the onsite entry process noted at the event. One entry per individual and one entry per team. Entry becomes void if the competitor withdraws from the event. If the winner is under the age of 18, a parent or guardian will need to be beside the winner at the presentation of the National Championships.

At each event, one person will be drawn from all those eligible. The winner from each event will then have a chance to win the Suzuki Swift drawn at the final event of the 2019/20 Suzuki Triathlon National Championships.

To be eligible for entry into the final draw, you must be present at the prize giving of the 2019/20 Suzuki Triathlon National Championships event you have just competed in. No proxy representation is allowed. The ballot will be re-drawn until a contestant is present to claim the prize. If due to extenuating circumstances the draw cannot occur at the Event prize giving, the draw will be drawn randomly and announced through social media and EDM with the winner being directly contacted prior.

### **Social Media Entry**

In addition to the Event Day Entry there will also be one social media entry which is added to the final prize draw. To be eligible for the social media entry you must have posted a picture of you competing at any 2019/20 Suzuki Triathlon National Championships Event on Facebook or Instagram, posted the picture between 11th August 2019 and 16th March 2020, included the #SuzukiNZTriChamps and tagged in @triathlonnz. The Social Media draw will be made randomly and will be announced on social media and in the Tribe on the 19th March 2020.

### **Final Draw for the prize**

The winner of the Suzuki Swift prize will be drawn from those finalists after the last event in the 2019/20 series\*\*. One winner will be announced. All finalists must be available on site or electronically (phone) to participate in the draw process and accept the prize and furthermore be available for any interviews / media requests.

For the final draw process, if the finalist is not on site, a representative will stand in for the purpose of the draw process only. The finalist will be involved in the draw via phone with that representative relaying the information as the draw process takes place. If the winner is under the age of 18, a parent or guardian will need to be beside the winner at the presentation of the final event.

The vehicle is to be 'registered in respect of the vehicle' in the parent's or guardian's name if the winner is under the age of 18, or does not have a current driver's licence.

There is only one prize of a Suzuki Swift GL Automatic valued at \$21,990+ on road costs. The vehicle will be supplied with 12 months registration and a full tank of fuel.

All entries become the property of Tri NZ. Tri NZ is not responsible for any lost, late, delayed, incorrect or misdirected entries.

Tri NZ's decision in relation to any aspect of the competition is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

The winner acknowledges that, to the extent permitted by law, Tri NZ accepts no responsibility or liability for any harm, damage, illness or injury, which may occur as a result of the winner winning the prize and the winner accepts and uses the prize at his or her own risk.

If the prize winner is aged between 16 and 18 years of age, the prize will be awarded to the prize winner's parent or legal guardian.

The Suzuki Swift prize will be made available for collection at the closest Suzuki dealership to the prize winner. A limited selection of colours will be available.

Tri NZ reserves the right to extend, postpone, or cancel the competition and to update these terms and conditions on [www.triathlon.kiwi](http://www.triathlon.kiwi) without notice. The winner will be responsible for any expenses incurred in collecting the car prize.

The prize winner may be required to sign a declaration confirming their eligibility to accept the prize. Tri NZ reserves the right to request the prize winners to provide proof of identity at the nominated prize collection address. Identification considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of Tri NZ. The prize is not transferable and not redeemable for cash.

Should this competition be cancelled notification will be published on Triathlon NZ website and through Triathlon New Zealand's media networks.
